

# Senior Cool Care 2025

## Overview

Dominion Energy sponsors the Senior Cool Care program by providing funding to the Area Agencies on Aging across the Commonwealth of Virginia for the purchase of fans, window A/C units and portable air conditioners for eligible older adults who need additional cooling devices in their homes.

## Program Details & Eligibility Information

<b>Program Dates</b>	<b>May 1<sup>st</sup> through October 31<sup>st</sup> 2025</b>
<b>Service Area</b>	<b>Each participating Area Agency on Aging will offer one cooling device per eligible household within their service area, as funding allows</b>
<b>Eligibility Criteria</b>	<b>Older adults age 60+ at or below 150% Federal Poverty Level (details below)</b>
<b>Income Eligibility: household of 1</b>	<b>Annual Income: \$29,325.00/per year or less</b>
	<b>Monthly Income: \$1,956/month or less</b>
<b>Income Eligibility: household of 2</b>	<b>Annual Income: \$39,645.00/per year or less</b>
	<b>Monthly Income: \$2,644/month or less</b>
